TECA GLOBAL TECHNOLOGIES INC ("we", "us", or "our") operates the Tryteca.com website (hereinafter referred to as the "Service"). This Privacy Policy informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data.
